





Media is a drop-in replacement for the Drupal core upload field with a unified User Interface where editors and administrators can upload, manage, and reuse files and multimedia assets. Any files uploaded before Media was



enabled will automatically take advantage of the many of the features it comes with.

Media's aim is to solve Drupal's long standing media handling problem.

Changes with the Drupal Association

The Drupal community is very special because of its culture of adapting to change, determination and passion, but also its fun and friendship. It is a combination that is hard to come by, even in the Open Source world. Our culture enabled us to work through really long, but ground-breaking release cycles, which also prompted us to celebrate the release of Drupal 8 with 240 parties around the world.

Throughout Drupal's 15 years history, that culture has served us really well. As the larger industry around us continues to change -- see my DrupalCon New Orleans keynote for recent examples -- we have been able to evolve Drupal accordingly. Drupal has not only survived massive changes in our industry; it has also helped drive them. Very few open source projects are 15 years old and continue to gain momentum.

Drupal 8 is creating new kinds of opportunities for Drupal. For example, who could have imagined that Lufthansa would be using Drupal 8 to build its next-generation in-flight entertainment system? Drupal 8 changes the kind of end-user experiences people can build, how we think about Drupal, and what kind of people we'll attract to our community. I firmly believe that these changes are positive for Drupal, increase Drupal's impact on the world, and grow the opportunity for our commercial ecosystem.

Basic settings

- Configure cron job (for drupal 6 http://drupal.org/project/poormanscron)
- 2. Make sure all cache tables are clearing properly especially cache form
- 3. Enable cache options in performance page
- (For Drupal 6, http://drupal.org/project/advagg)

Theme optimization

- 1. Manually Remove blankspaces and comments from .tpl
- 2. No indentation in .tpl
- 3. Turn on CSS and JS aggregation in the performance page
- 4. Manually reduce css file size by removing duplicate and combine similar together
- Move codes to functions which should be in a custom common module. Use functions for similar problems instead of coding separately. Refer core API

The order of chapters is an attempt at identifying the priority of the configuration based upon the likelihood that it will be helpful, and the potential benefit/harm of the configuration.

Site administrators should also sign up for the security mailing list. People interested in discussing security should join Best Practices in Security Group.

There are a number of contributed modules which can help with security, not all of which are documented in this handbook. One such is the Security Review module which provides an analysis of your security configuration.
